Timeline

Learn about the stages your In Vitro Fertilization (IVF) treatment will go through.



Donor Selection

The patient selects 3 preferred donors from our platform. Our egg donation team then confirms the availability and compatibility of the first choice. Once confirmed, the donor is reserved.



Fertilization and Embryo Culture (3-5 days)

In vitro fertilization is performed, and embryos are cultured until the blastocyst stage.



Endometrial Preparation

The recipient patient begins hormonal treatment to prepare for the embryo transfer.



Embryo Transfer

One or more embryos are transferred into the uterus.



Pregnancy Test (10 days later)

A blood test is performed to confirm pregnancy.

Some stages may vary slightly depending on the clinical case and individual response to treatment. Additionally, further studies, hormonal tests, genetic evaluations, or complementary treatments—such as endometrial preparation prior to a frozen embryo transfer—may be required, which are not reflected in this general timeline.

Frozen Donor lot (6 to 8 eggs), anesthesiologist, ICSI, embryo culture, and embryo transfer.

1. General Conditions

- All packages include only the procedures specified in the selected treatment program.
- Medications are not included. The estimated cost is approximately \$500, but this may vary depending on the medical protocol and the patient's individual response.

2. Additional Services and Fees

- If PGT-A or a Frozen Embryo Transfer (FET) is requested, an additional payment timeline will apply.
- Annual embryo storage has a cost of \$400, billed from the date the first batch is frozen.

3. Payment Timeline

For egg donation treatments, full payment is required before beginning the process. If the treatment includes PGT-A or a frozen transfer, additional payments will be made as the cycle progresses:

- Before starting: treatment package + monitoring
- After biopsy (Day 5): PGT-A payment
- Before frozen transfer: FET payment + endometrial monitoring

^{*}Remote Monitoring includes: communication, review, and integration of results with the Panama Fertility team.

4. Cancellation and Refund Policies

- Once the donor is assigned and the protocol has begun, cancellations or donor changes are not allowed, except in medically justified cases.
- If no eggs are retrieved during aspiration, a new batch will be assigned at no additional cost, but only if the failure is attributable to the donor.
- No full or partial refunds will be granted if no viable embryos are obtained or if no embryo transfer takes place.
- If the recipient chooses to postpone or cancel the transfer, she will be responsible for covering the cost of a new endometrial preparation cycle.
